ENTERING THE TEST

Wherever the word "dog" is used in this premium, it includes both sexes. These tests are open to all dogs six (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP prefix), an AKC Canine Partners listing (MA prefix) or are approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Rottweilers are given entry preference in all tests.

ENTRY FEES AND INFORMATION FOR ENTERING

Entry fees include a \$3.50 AKC recording fee and are to be in US Dollars only.

Mail entry forms and fees to: Jill Grant, 1607 Red Mountain Dr., Longmont CO 80405. Make checks payable to "American Rottweiler Club". Phone or fax entries will not be accepted. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted, which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. A valid tracking dog certification must accompany each entry.

Errors on Entry: Owners are responsible for errors on entry forms, whoever may make such errors. No entry fee will be refunded in event of errors. Entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered, or substituted after the entries have closed.

Receipt of entries will be acknowledged via email (when a valid email address is provided on the entry form).

ENTRY FEES AND INFORMATION FOR ENTERING

100% of entry fees will be refunded (checks destroyed) for any reason if written (or email) request is received by the TEST SECRETARY on or before the closing day and time.

No entry fee will be refunded if the test cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

In the event an accepted entry cancels following the closing of entries, the Test Secretary shall contact alternates according to their placement on the Alternates List. Upon such notification, alternates shall have the option of accepting or refusing the opportunity to participate in the test. In the event an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, it shall be the responsibility of the Test Secretary to determine if alternates are present and, by their position on the Alternates List, determine which of the alternates shall participate.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent (see below), disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from participation by action of the Test Committee. Bitches in season may participate per Ch2, Sec 8, Tracking Regulations.

Entry fees will be refunded for: (a) an alternate who does not participate, and (b) an entry who is absent by virtue of having earned, after the close of entries, the title for the test in which entered, provided a properly entered alternate is available and runs said track.

Refunds will be mailed within fourteen (14) days following the test.

DRAW

In accordance with AKC Obedience Regulations, entries in these tests will be accepted up to the official closing date and time, even though the advertised limits may have been reached.

Should the number of entries exceed the number of tracks available, a drawing to determine which entries will participate in the tests will be held March 20, 2024, at 8:00 PM MST at the home of Jill Grant, 1607 Red Mountain Dr, Longmont, CO 80405. Any interested parties are welcome to attend.

The drawing for participation will be conducted by the Test Secretary and shall be completely random among all entries received, except that Rottweilers will be drawn separately and given preference over other breeds and All-American dogs. Preference shall be given to dogs that have not earned the title for the test they are entering.

When the advertised limit for each test has been drawn, all of the remaining entries shall be similarly drawn and assigned a position on the appropriate Alternates List, subject to the same preference set forth above. The Test Secretary shall then notify all entries of the results for the drawing.

The AKC Regulations for Tracking Tests are available from the American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Raleigh NC 27617-3390, or from the AKC web site.

A test secretary may be eligible to enter dogs they own or co-own, if allowed by the host club (see Chapter 1, Section 12 of AKC's Tracking Regulations).

TEST DAY DRAWING FOR ORDER OF TRACKS

Draw for order of running of TD tracks will take place on April 21, 2024, at the Boyd Lake Test Headquarters at 7:15 AM MST.

The first track will be run as soon as time and weather permits. The Club may cancel the event in case of extreme weather conditions.

DIRECTIONS TO TEST HEADQUARTERS

From I-25, take Hwy 34 west. Turn north on N Boise Ave, then right on E 37th St. Park entrance is on the right. After passing through the entry booth, go straight after the first stop sign into the swim beach parking lot.

From Ridgeline Hotel (host hotel): Turn left onto 1st St., turn right onto US-36/N St Vrain, turn left onto Mall Rd., turn right onto US-34, turn left on N Boise Ave, then turn right on E 37th St. Park entrance is on right. **A State Park pass is required for all vehicles entering the park. Daily passes may be purchased at the park entrance kiosk.**

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Passing teams will receive a rosette, and an Armetale plate. Passing Rottweiler teams will also receive a commemorative Rottweiler rosette.

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR, and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this test, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor who themselves or whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

The American Rottweiler Club, the Test Secretary, and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The American Rottweiler Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the American Rottweiler Club or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times.

The American Rottweiler club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for these tests.

INSTRUCTIONS 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., A or B division.
3. (Owner) A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.

These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
